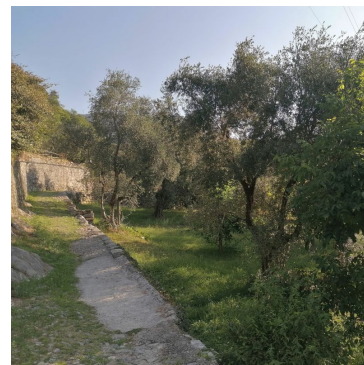

WONDERFUL VIEWS AMONG RICH VILLAS, HAMLETS AND CHURCHES

Tremezzina is the name of a country which has been including the villages of Tremezzo, Ossuccio, Mezzega e Lenno since 2014. It is mainly well known for treasures such as Villa del Balbianello and Villa Carlotta, only to mention some and which we visited on different excursions: it is less known for its rocky walls and olive groves hiding small chapels, monasteries, hamlets, ancient noble villas.

An itinerary partly along the well-known Lake Como Greenway and partly on mountain paths sometimes rocky but never risky, which will amaze you because of the hamlets hiding important noble villas but also ancient rural houses where nativities have been installed and open to visitors.

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Difference in altitude: 1148 feet

Distance: 6.8 miles

Max Altitude: 1460 feet above sea level

DESCRIPTION

The itinerary starts at Villa Carlotta or Tremezzo pier (according to season) and runs up to San Martino Church where we can enjoy a wonderful view on Lake Como, Bellagio hills and the Lecco branch of the Lario. Grigna and Grignetta rocky mountains, our local highest peaks, can be seen in the background quite protecting hills descending to the lake shores.

The passage from the church to Rogaro plain, a stretch of cultivated fields in a particularly sunny and scenic place which is well-known among Star Wars fans, is the most demanding and rocky in the day requiring to be more careful.

Afterwards we will walk on easy and comfortable cobblestone paths at the foot of the rocky wall created by the alpine orogenesis, passing through ancient hamlets where ancient and noble villas, monasteries and rural houses can be found one near to the other, up to Mezzegra and its impressive church.

From here we will enjoy our last view on Lake Como and Grosgalli coast before descending back to Lenno pier.

Tasting lunch in a typical restaurant along the way.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY - MEDIUM

Terrain: mostly on cobblestone pedestrian paths and sometimes rocky mountain trails;

Gradient: moderate;

Attention points: some rocky paths requiring to be more careful

Itinerary suitable for adults and children/teens over 10 in good health conditions and used to walk in the mountains.

Dogs must be kept on a leash in order to respect any wild animal and other participants who could be afraid or annoyed. Please, prevent the Guide.

Programme

- 8.40am meeting point at Lenno pier.
- 9.00am boat to Villa Carlotta
- 9.15am excursion to San Martino back to Lenno pier; lunch along the way in a local and typical restaurant.
- 4.30/5pm back to Lenno pier.

ATTENTION: Programme and itinerary may vary according to trail and weather conditions to guarantee safety for trekkers and also according to boat schedule.

CANCELLATION/POSTPONEMENT

The excursion can be cancelled or postponed anytime by the Guide at her absolute discretion, in case safe and proper conditions cannot be guaranteed following bad weather conditions on the day of the excursion or on the previous days.

Any fee paid will be considered valid as a voucher on the next excursion, max validity 1 year, or refunded (foreign people only).

No refund is due in case of cancellation by the participant on the day before or on the same day of the excursion.

How to reach the meeting point

Lenno is on the Como shores of Lake Como. Free or paying car parking lots.
Cars can be shared in Como, on request, where 2 train stations are connected to Milan.

Clothes and equipment

- Trekking shoes with gripping sole to walk safely on rocky paths;
- Backpack to carry personal belongings, spare clothing, and food and water supplies.
- Dress in layers according to the season (shirt, long-sleeved shirt, Fleece jacket or sweatshirt, rain and wind stopper jacket);
- Rain poncho in case of unstable weather.

Trekkers non adequately equipped will not be allowed to the excursion.

Containment measures
