SNOWY WEEKEND IN ALPE CAMPAGNEDA AND ALPE PRABELLO TO TASTE LOCAL PRODUCTS - VALMALENCO

Alpe Campagneda is an alpine pasture at 7,000 feet where a wonderful cheese is produced in summer, at the foot of Pizzo Scalino; while Alpe Prabello is a small group of rural houses which have been restored and in winter the atmosphere is magic.

Our itinerary with snowshoes will be around the 2 alpine pastures offering wonderful views on Disgrazia Peak and Scalino Peak, in search for soft hills where to experiment untouched snow hiking far from tracked paths. Hiking, and sometime sinking into the untouched and white cover of snow, is a wonderful emotion!!

Overnight at the farmhouse and dinner including local products.

Saturday Difference in altitude: 525 feet Lenght: 1,2 miles Max altitude 7000 feet above sea level

Sunday Difference in elevation: 850 feet ascent and 1345 feet descent Lenght: 6 miles Max altitude 7600 feet above sea level

DIFFICULTY LEVEL: MEDIUM

Itinerary on snow-covered environment whose conditions could vary according to varous factors among which temperature and kind of snow. Suitable for adults and teens over 12 in good health conditions.

Dogs must be on a leash owing to the presence of wild animals in the wood and out of respect for other participants who could be afraid of or annoyed by them. Do not hesitate to contact the Guide.

- is culturally sensitive, engenders respect between tourists and hosts, and builds local pride and confidence.

Programme

<u>Saturday</u>

- Meeting point at 3pm at the large car parking after Campo Franscia in Valmalenco (direction Lanzada and Campo Moro from Chiesa Valmalenco); alternatively and on request meeting point in Lecco Bione;
- 3.30pm Snowshoes excursion to the lodge; accommodation and optional hiking in the snow at sunset; dinner with local products;

<u>Sunday</u>

- 8.30/9.00 Breakfast and excursion amonh alpine pastures according to snow conditions and safety;
- back at the lodge for late afternoon break;
- Back to parking. ACCOMMODATION WILL BE ONLY IN 4 or 6-PEOPLE DORMITORY WITH ALSO DOUBLE BUNK BEDS.

Please arrange your backpack so to leave some stuffs at the farmhouse/lodge.

CANCELLATION/POSTPONEMENT

The excursion can be cancelled or postponed anytime by the Guide at her absolute discretion, in case safe and proper conditions cannot be guaranteed following bad weather conditions on the day of the excursion or on the previous days.

Excursion could be confirmed even if weather conditions are not good but safe for participants.

Any fees paid will be considered valid as a voucher on the next excursion – max validity 1 year - or refunded (only for foreign people).

No refund is due in case of cancellation by the participant less than 2 days from the date of the excursion.

Injury insurance

INJURY INSURANCE FOR TREKKERS

Participation fee only includes liability insurance; NO injury insurance coverage is provided to Participants to the excursion. It is advisable to take out a suitable injury insurance.

EIC Organization offer an annual injury insurance which can be activated by the Trip&Trek app and amounting to 10 euros per year, per person. The insurance is valid 1 year whenever you participate to an excursion with and AIGAE Guide. For more details, please contact info@escursioni-italia.it.

How to reach the meeting point

Car parking is after Campo Franscia, direction Lanzada, Campo Moro from Chiesa Valmalenco. After Campo Franscia, the road is winding. GOOD WINTER TYRES OR SNOW CHAINS ON BOARD ARE COMPULSORY. Paid car parking: 8 euros/2 days

Bione car parking is at the exit from SS36 and it is convinient in case we want to share cars.

Clothes and Equipmemt

- Winter trekking shoes, waterproof and having gripping soles;
- Trekking poles with large washers COMPULSORY to improve performance in deep snow;
- Snow gaiter recommended;
- Snowshoes;
- Trekking Backpack for 2 days (45-50 l.) including hot beverages and food supplies, spare clothes for 2 days and the night, towels, and personal belongings; reduce personal belongings at the minimum;
- Smaller backpack for the day OR fabric bag to contain stuffs not needed dutring the excursion.

ATTENTION: trekking backpack must be max 40-50 l. and suitable to accommodate also snowshoes and having side belts.

- Packed lunch;
- Dress in layers (technical underwear, t-shirt, long-sleeved shirt, micro fleece, light duvet, softshell, gloves and wool cap); BIG DUVET AS FIRST COVER IS NOT RECOMMANDED.
- Sunglasses;
- Headlamp;

In case of doubt do not hesitate to contact me.

ONLY ONE BACKPACK MAX 40-50 L. IS ALLOWED TO BE CARRIED DURING THE EXCURSION.

Trekkers not adequately equipped will not be allowed to participate to the excursions.

Please note that after we will leave some stuffs at the farmhouse/lodge during our excursion.
